Plantar warts are characterized by small, fleshy growths on the bottom of the foot, which may be rough or grainy. These warts cause hard, thickened skin where a wart has grown inward and produce black pinpoints in the center of the growth, which are clotted blood vessels. They are caused by HPV, when the virus enters the human body through tiny cuts, breaks or other weak spots on the bottom of the feet. The virus thrives in warm and moist environments, making locker rooms and swimming pools a common source of infection. Other risk factors include having had prior warts and poor immune function.

While they are not often a serious health concern and will eventually go away without treatment, they can actually be quite painful when pressure is applied, affecting walking and day to day function. Waiting for them to disappear on their own may take time, as South Coast Foot and Ankle Associates points out that it can

even take up to a few years. People who are dealing with plantar warts will either have to try self-care methods or see a podiatrist to have the warts removed. However, traditional methods for removing plantar warts can be quite involved. Salicylic acid, cryotherapy, chemo-based fluorouracil or bleomycin and surgical removal? the most common methods for removing plantar warts traditionally? are all painful and invasive, and require multiple sessions to complete.


