The result is an epoxy resin that is water clear in the bottle and stays clear for the long-term after curing. The glossy finish can add a significant layer of depth to any artwork, as well as protecting art pieces from damage. The recent YouTube video from the company explains exactly how to do this.

ArtResin's Epoxy Resin is incredibly easy to use, even for beginners to epoxy resin. Epoxy resin comes in two parts, the resin and the hardener. The two parts remain liquid as long as they're separate, and begin to harden after mixing. To use ArtResin Epoxy Resin, equal portions of the resin and hardener must be mixed together. The combination should be stirred for three minutes before being poured over the top of the project and spread into an even layer. ArtResin is self-leveling, so artists never have to worry about a perfect spread. Once the resin is in place, it needs to be left alone to dry for 24 hours to ensure a strong, hard surface.

The resin is also formulated specifically for use in art, which is why the formulation has such a focus on protection against yellowing. The formula is also non-toxic, an safe for home use when used in a well-ventilated area. The resin contains no volatile organic compounds that produce fumes and could cause

adverse health effects, and is free from BPA plastics. Epoxy resins tend to produce strong fumes, which is one of the problems the founders of ArtResin set out to solve when designing their product. The epoxy resin is even food safe once cured, so it can be used for projects that may come in contact with food without fear of harm. The product has been highly reviewed, with many customers leaving photos of the incredible art they made, enhanced, and protected with it.
