Because of the sensitive nature of this condition, many men resort to taking herbal remedies, over-the-counter drugs, or supplements instead of seeking medical advice, but this may cause more damage, particularly if the medicine or supplement taken interacts with current medications.

When consulting with a certified medical professional about ED, the doctor will review the patient's medical history and conduct a physical exam. The patient's testosterone levels may also be monitored, and the medications used, and lifestyle factors such as smoking, drug use, and drinking alcohol may be closely examined. The doctor will also look at the patient's health condition because ED may also be a sign of severe health problems, such as diabetes; heart disease; cardiovascular disease; low testosterone; high blood pressure; obstructive sleep apnea; chronic inflammation; anxiety; stress; depression; and side effects of medication, such as blood pressure medications.

For most men, oral medication may be effective enough for ED. However, some of the PDE5 inhibitors should not be taken by those taking nitrates, such as isosorbide and nitroglycerin. They should also be taken cautiously by men taking alpha-adrenergic blockers due to the risk of low blood pressure. Thus, it is essential to let the doctor know what drugs one is taking before they prescribe medication for ED.

The most common ED medications are Tadalafil (Cialis), Sildenafil (Viagra); Vardenafil (Levitra); and Avanafil (Stendra). These are prescription drugs that boost nitric oxide levels in the blood. The nitric oxide causes the

blood vessels to widen and help increase the blood flow such that more blood in the penis will make it easier to get an erection and maintain it when a man is sexually aroused.

The article also offers some tips for men to boost their confidence and comfort level when they talk to their doctor about ED. Rehearsing what they're going to say at their in-person appointment might help, and the article suggests several statements to start the conversation. It is also essential to go to the appointment prepared with a list of questions to ask the doctor. It is also a good idea to list their symptoms beforehand because the doctor will certainly ask them. Those who notice that their doctor is not comfortable when discussing ED or aren't getting the information they think they should, can ask for a referral to an ED treatment specialist.
