Jason Muzzy, owner of Commonwealth Waste Solutions, offers the following advice, "When using a new septic tank, it is vital to: follow the manufacturer's instructions for how often to pump out the tank; only flush toilet paper and human waste down the toilet - everything else goes in the garbage can; keep an eye on your water usage and avoid running the dishwasher or washing machine unnecessarily; and have your septic tank inspected at least once every one to three years to ensure it's in good condition."

Regular pumping of the septic tank is vital because it will have an accumulation of solid waste over time and this must be eliminated. If this is not removed, the effluent will be overloaded with solid waste that will then escape to the drain field and cause damage. If this is neglected over a significant amount of time, ultimately it will result in a sewage backup, which means the presence of foul odors in the kitchen, bathroom, and laundry room, and particularly in and around the yard where the septic system is located. It may also result into slow flushing or gurgling in toilets and drains, plus the presence of sewage in showers, drains, and bathtubs.

The professional technicians from Commonwealth Waste Solutions typically arrive at a client's home fully equipped with the appropriate tools and knowledge. They will locate the septic tank and expose its access lids to gain entry into the tank. They will get rid of all the waste from the tank, including both solids and liquids, and then properly dispose of this waste at an authorized sewage treatment facility. When required, they will inform the county about the service provided.

Commonwealth Waste Solutions also frequently provides septic system inspections to help homeowners find out if their septic tank requires effluent filter cleaning and pumping and cleaning.
