They can be used to replace both single and multiple teeth giving patients a viable option to outdated methods which ended up being either uncomfortable or affecting the natural tooth structure. Implants can even be used alongside removable dentures to anchor or improve the stability of the dentures. Cosmetically, dental implants are also superior to dentures and bridges as they look natural and are almost indistinguishable from the real thing, especially if installed by experts, such as the doctors and medical professionals at Sydney Holistic Dental Centre.

Implants come in several different types that are useful for different patient complaints. For example, implants

can be used to replace a single tooth, multiple teeth, or even full-mouth replacement or full denture support. Full mouth reconstructions can be achieved by placing implants to which fixed bridges are attached or by placing implants that can support removable dentures. Either way, the results from full mouth reconstructions are comparable to natural dentition.

In terms of material composition, construction, and placement, dental implants are small titanium screws that are placed into the jawbone. Dental implants provide a platform on which to construct crowns or bridges to replace missing teeth and preserve the bone from eroding after teeth are lost. Titanium is used because the metal is strong, lightweight, and doesn?t react with the body?s fluids such as blood and saliva. The crowns that are used as teeth that sit on top of the implants are made using ceramic material.

However, dental implants are not the silver bullet to solve every problem. Some patients may not have the suitable bone structure or bone density to support them. A spokesperson for Sydney Holistic Dental Centre talks about the considerations that one should make before deciding on dental implants by saying, ?The first thing to investigate is whether the patient has a sensitivity or allergy to the metal used for dental implants, namely titanium. Though it usually does not react to the body?s organic material, some may have an adverse reaction to it. The second consideration is the patient?s overall health. This includes diagnosing for conditions such as osteoporosis which can lead to weakened bones preventing the dentist from ensuring long-lasting results. Finally, we do our due diligence to find out the root cause of why the teeth were lost in the first place. If the root cause for losing teeth was an infection, a dental implant will not last unless the original problem is addressed.
