for water to drain. Boiling water also works for this purpose, especially if the clog is based on grease or soap

buildup, as the heat helps to dissolve some of this mess. Some people reportedly also resort to snaking tools,

which can be purchased at many home hardware stores. These can be quite handy, but need to be used

correctly or they will only block the drain further or cause damage to pipes.
