These beaches are Alder Lane Beach, Burkes Beach, Coligny Beach, Driessen Beach, Fish Haul Beach, Folly Field Beach, and Island's Beach.

In addition to beaches, the complimentary tourist magazine lists various low-key activities but emphasizes the history and culture of Hilton Head. Consequently, the 101 Things to Do list includes a visit to the Coastal Discovery Museum. This place reflects the Lowcountry's cultural legacy and history, its ecosystem, and its former inhabitants.

The Coastal Discovery Museum is located on the historic Honey Horn, a 68-acre site on the banks of Jarvis Creek that dates back 300 years and is regarded as one of the Island's most historically significant locations. It is the sole remaining original plantation mansion on Hilton Head Island. A collection of some of the oldest structures on Hilton Head Island, the butterfly habitat, exploration lab, and dragonfly pond are accessible to visitors.
