These flags have sewn stripes, and the nylon has been treated so that the flag material is resistant to deterioration and fading caused by the sun. Also, the fly end is quadruple stitched to ensure that the flag will hold up in spite of strong, rough winds. As with all their other flags, the new Thin Red Line flag and Thin Blue Line flags are 100 percent made in the US, using American labor and materials. The Thin Blue Line flag is a symbol used by law enforcement. While it was first used in the UK, it is now widely used in the United States and Canada as a way to remember the fallen and to display support for current law enforcement officers. Furthermore, it also symbolizes the role of police officers in the community as they protect civilians from various criminal situations. The Thin Blue Line flag is made with three lines. The top black line symbolizes the public, and the bottom black line is a symbol for lawbreakers. The thin blue line that is positioned in between the two black lines represents the law enforcement. The concept is that law enforcement is what is standing between the wrongs performed by the criminals and the public, which are their potential victims, by protecting them through their service each day.

Meanwhile, the Thin Red Line flag was created to give support to fire service personnel and to honor injured or fallen firefighters. The color red, which can be easily noticed, has been used for many years as a way to warn others about unsafe situations and to clear the way for firefighters to pass by. For the same reason, fire trucks are typically red or will contain a significant amount of red color. The Thin Red Line flag was developed with basically the same purpose as the Thin Blue line flag, but this time to express support for the fire department and the firefighters who have been injured and killed in the line of duty. The term "thin red line" originated during the Crimean War in 1854 and represents strong defense against the enemy. Since then, the term "thin red line" has been used to represent any thinly spread military unit holding against an attack. In 1999, firefighters from the Apex Volunteer Fire Department in North Carolina created the Thin Red Line to show respect for firefighters.
