NexGen is a desktop fleet management software that offers various features, such as: quoting, scheduling, safety, service, reporting, and integrations. The quoting feature allows the users to save time during the

quoting process and get rid of the need for duplicative data entry. Its centralized system facilitates the way for employees to come up with a quote fast with accurate customer, equipment, job site, safety certifications, and personnel information.

The NexGen scheduling feature enhances accuracy and eliminates errors when scheduling jobs. Its safety feature ensures the safety of personnel through the monitoring, tracking, and maintaining of certifications. Its service feature allows the tracking of preventive maintenance and repairs and the automation of notifications of past due and coming due service. NexGen also has reporting features that allow the company to boost revenue by assessing equipment usage to measure ROI and make better business decisions. It also integrates seamlessly with typical GPS and accounting systems.
