This keeps the airways open and allows the patient to breathe normally.

Patients who believe they have sleep apnea will need to consult with their doctor and get a prescription for a CPAP machine. They may then choose from the various CPAP machines available through Insurance Covered CPAP and fill out the online form available on the website. Estimates indicate that about one in 15 people suffer from sleep apnea and that 80 percent who have it are undiagnosed. If the condition is left untreated, it can lead to potentially life-threatening health issues, including stroke and other heart problems.

A CPAP machine is equipped with a compressor that serves as the source of the continuous stream of pressurized air that goes through an air filter and goes to the patient through a mask that is sealed and worn around the nose and mouth. A potential downside of a CPAP machine is that the patient may need some time to get used to wearing the mask while sleeping. It should be noted, however, that the potential advantages for the sleep apnea patient are significant and more than make up for the discomfort. These include: reduction and even possible elimination of snoring; assurance that the airway is always open while the patient is asleep; improvement of the quality of sleep; reduction or even elimination of sleepiness during the daytime; and decrease in high blood pressure.
