It is a 36-foot, 20-passenger, custom-built pontoon boat with cycle seats around a bar. Customers pedal from these seats to propel the ship.

In addition to water-based activities, the 101 Things to Do Magazine offers a variety of land-based activities. Stoney-Baynard Ruins are a site to see in Hilton Head. The ruins recount the rich history of the Stoney and Baynard families of Hilton Head Island. They are also included on the National Register of Historic Places. Those interested in Hilton Head Island's past may also visit the Heritage Library, which is committed to studying and preserving national and ancestral history.

Those who want to see Hilton Head Island from a unique vantage point may climb the Lighthouse. This red-and-white-striped Lighthouse became a Hilton Head Island icon and worldwide emblem. The Lighthouse may be seen at the Harbour Town Yacht Basin. Visitors must ascend 114 stairs to reach the summit, which offers an extra thrill to the journey. The Lighthouse also contains a museum with a rare collection of images and artifacts from the nineteenth century and the American Civil War.
