Depending on the offense, you may be issued a Desk Appearance Ticket (DAT) instead of being held for a formal arrest process. While desk appearance tickets are still very serious, they will allow you to go home temporarily and appear in court at a designated time and place," says the New York City desk appearance ticket lawyer.

The lawyer explains that being issued a desk appearance ticket does not automatically mean that the person is guilty. Anything a person does or says when arrested can be used against them. If a person is issued a DAT they should seek the help of an experienced lawyer right away.

Attorney Russ Kofman adds that a desk appearance ticket is a legal document that orders a person to appear in court at a specific place, date, and time. While the person is not going through the formal arrest process, a desk appearance ticket is still considered an arrest. When a person appears in court at the date and time designated, you will be expected to respond to accusations that you committed a crime.

According to the lawyer, ?Not all offenses will be considered for a desk appearance ticket. A DAT is most often issued for misdemeanors and some Class E felony offenses. These are still very serious criminal charges, and a desk appearance ticket should be taken seriously. Before a desk appearance ticket is issued, law enforcement will verify that you have a local address. They will also check to see if you have a prior criminal record. If you have a record, you will not be issued a DAT.?

Lastly, attorney Kofman emphasizes the importance of having a skilled lawyer when dealing with a DAT. An experienced lawyer may be able to help the defendant understand their rights and protect their freedom.
