Owner and founder of Reel Time Fishing Toby Wyatt says, "We offer walleye fishing year round, but the best time for them is early spring through late summer. Reel Time Fishing operates boats on the Snake and Columbia Rivers just dedicated for walleye fishing. Both of these rivers are chocked full of walleye, ranging in size from 1 to 17 pounds, and we would be glad to give you a guided fishing tour."

The walleye is the largest member of the perch family. They grow to more than 30 inches, live to seven or eight years old, weigh 12-15 pounds and make for excellent fishing. According to Reel Time Fishing, walleye spawn in the Spring and Fall and can be found in shallow flats during that time. In the summer, they can be

found in deeper water near points of sharp ledges and bars. Reel Time Fishing explains that walleye have better vision under low light conditions, which makes early mornings or late evenings best for fishing.

Reel Time Fishing's expert guides use a variety of techniques to target walleye. During cold water conditions in the winter and early spring, they will use a vertical jig (with one ounce jig heads) with hoochies and worms. When the water begins to warm up, the fish will begin to move into shallower water where trolling deep-diving crankbaits is the key to success. As the season progresses, Reel Time Fishing's guides then follow the fish back into the deep water by trolling worms with bottom bouncers. According to the company, this method produces the best outcomes during warm water conditions.

Wyatt says, "Catching walleye can be a bit challenging as they tend to move a lot and change what they want to eat, but if you are fishing with us, you have no need to worry. Our guided tours are here to make sure the learning curve is easy to master for anyone interested in fishing for walleye! Get in touch with us today and reserve your fishing adventure!?"
