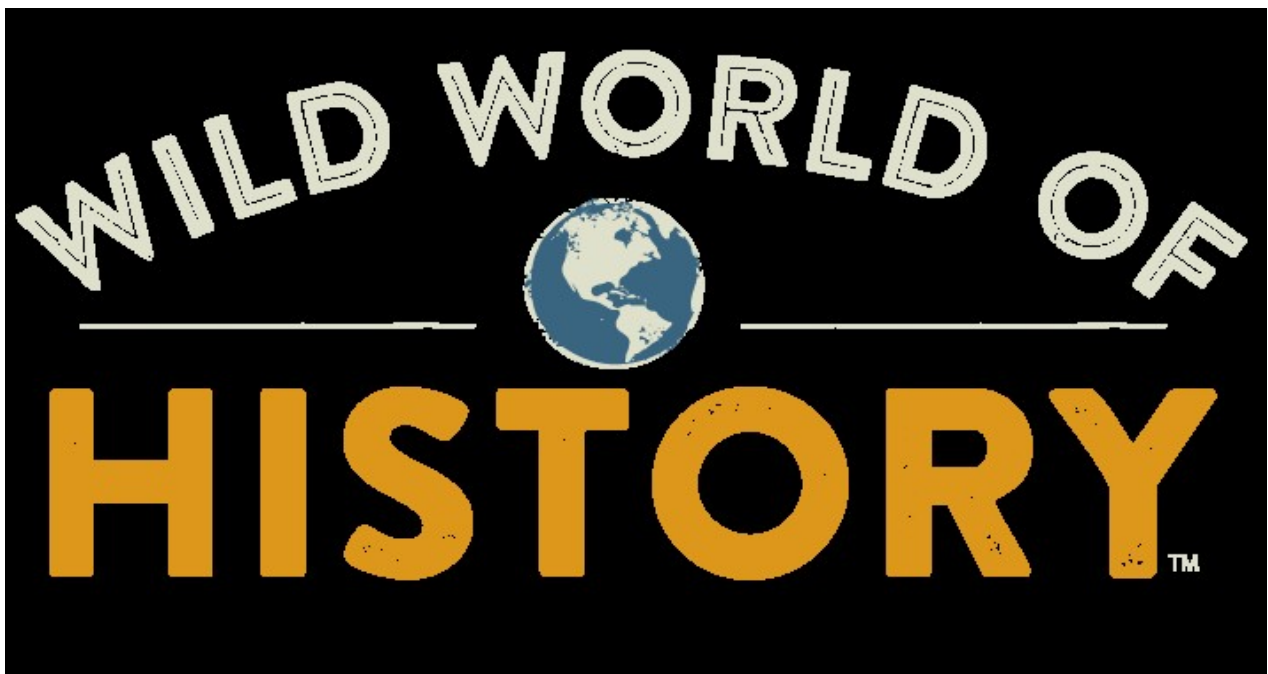




Wild World of History Explains How Their Homeschool Curriculum Is Different from Any Other in the Market

He wants to emphasize that teaching is actually a "learning process for both the student and the teacher" and that teachers need to follow four basic principles, which are: being confident; being balanced and understanding one's bias; teaching the big picture, and using a variety of teaching methods.

This bundle is suitable for middle-high school students. It is important to note that the foundation of this bundle is a video-based American history curriculum.

Also added are invitations to Professor Larry's weekly Wild Wednesday webcasts plus Q&A. The video-based full American history curriculum course traces the history of the USA from its founding through 1877 to the end of the Reconstruction. Of special emphasis are the four pillars of American exceptionalism, which are: common law; mostly Protestant Christian religious foundation; a free market economy; and private property with written deeds and titles.

For those who need a world history curriculum, they offer the World History Curriculum + eBooks, which is designed to teach the children real-world history with Professor Schweikart, America's History Teacher. This can offer the students a deep understanding of how the rest of the world had helped to shape America and how the country had coexisted with the rest of the world. This bundle includes a full year of video-based world history curriculum; review questions; tests with answer keys; teacher guidebook; "A Patriot's History of the Modern World" in 2 volumes, in ebook format; and extra activities to reinforce lessons. This package is relevant for middle to high school students. It also includes invitations to his Wild Wednesday Webcasts and Q&A. In the first volume of the e-book, it is shown how American exceptionalism was victorious over liberal progressivism, although the latter had a few temporary victories. In the second volume, Professor Larry traces world history from the Cold War to the Age of Entitlement, which is from 1945 to 2012.
