This is done to see if one driver was in violation of the law at the time of the accident. If the driver was violating a traffic law, they will be considered to be at fault for the accident. It is very important to call the police at the scene of the accident in order to be able to establish fault against the other party.

In the article, attorney Charlip says that "Lastly, insurance companies and police will also accept statements from anyone who witnessed the accident. Witnesses can include any parties involved in the accident as well as any passengers in their vehicle and bystanders who saw the incident. The police may also act as a witness based on the evidence they have collected at the scene. It is important for anyone involved in an accident to not admit fault immediately after the accident."
