It is important to note that sleep apnea is a possibly life-threatening condition that occurs when the throat airway narrows down or gets blocked because of the throat muscles relaxing during sleep, resulting into a significant decrease in the amount of oxygen that the patient receives while sleeping. Statistics indicate that one in 15 people suffer from sleep apnea and that 80 percent who suffer from it are undiagnosed. If the condition is just left untreated, it may result into potentially life-threatening health problems, such as a stroke and other heart issues.

A CPAP machine has a compressor that pumps a continuous stream of pressurized air that goes through an air filter and then delivered to the patient through a mask that is sealed and worn around the patient's mouth and nose. A possible problem with a CPAP machine is that the patient may have to get used to wearing the mask while sleeping. It should be pointed out, however, that the potential benefits provided by the CPAP machine for the sleep apnea patient far outweigh the initial discomfort that the patient will need to go through.

Those who suspect they may have sleep apnea are encouraged to consult with their doctor and obtain a prescription for a CPAP machine. They may then choose from the various CPAP machines available through Insurance Covered CPAP and fill out the online form available on the website.
