They?re protein building blocks that also construct enzymes. In particular, histidine is an essential amino acid that contributes to cell function; supplementation is required though because the human body is not capable of making it.?

TFMC explains histidine may help lessen oxidative stress and improve cellular function in the body when

combined with other IV amino acids. Since the clinic offers a range of IV therapy drips, they may cater to each patient?s individual needs.

During consultation, a patient could learn more about the effects of histidine. It is believed that inflammation is the root cause of many chronic diseases, and histidine?s natural antioxidative, anti-inflammatory effects may be one of the suitable answers to this issue. The article says, ?When histidine is mixed with alanine, carnosine is constructed, which is generally found in brain tissue and cardiac and skeletal muscles in ample concentrations. According to studies, carnosine has the ability to sift through reactive oxygen species (which are chemicals that may cause DNA damage) due to its antioxidant effects. Carnosine may be advantageous towards combatting or managing metabolic, neurological, and cardiovascular disease.?

The Toronto Functional Medicine Centre adds that some research indicates that histidine might reduce fatigue when ingested. A 2015 study explains they had participants with excess fatigue take histidine for a brief period. In addition to managing their fatigue level, it was also reported that they experienced improved attention span and clarity. Another study on middle-aged women with obesity and metabolic syndrome found that the participants showed a significant increase in insulin sensitivity after taking histidine for 12 weeks. They also experienced a reduction in BMI, waist circumference, and body fat.

Notably, the article cautions people against attempting to take histidine without professional oversight. Patients with other health concerns are also advised to check with a functional medicine practitioner. At the Toronto Functional Medicine Centre, histidine may be offered (if necessary) alongside other supplements to address the patient?s needs.
