



## **Miami Car Accident Lawyer David Charlip Explains the Personal Injury Protection Insurance for Lost Wages in Florida**

The lawyer mentions that lost wages in a car accident refer to income lost due to injuries sustained in a car accident. If a person is not able to show up for work because of their injuries, they may be entitled to receive payment for the wages they could have earned.

According to the Miami car accident lawyer, "There are two types of compensation that you may recover depending on your case. These types of damages are "lost compensation" and "loss of future earning capacity". The loss of future earning capacity refers to the financial benefits you will receive if your injury results in your inability to work in the future or if your injury results in permanent disability. On the other hand, lost compensation refers to all the financial benefits you would have received if the accident had not happened, including lost wages."

The lawyer mentions that Florida insurance regulations require that all drivers purchase no-fault insurance coverage. Personal Injury Protection (PIP) insurance pays compensation, regardless of who causes the car accident. To be eligible for PIP benefits, it is important for a car accident victim to seek medical treatment within 14 days of the accident.

Attorney David H. Charlip adds that the policy terms will determine the amount of the loss of income claim. Drivers in Florida must have a minimum of \$10,000 in PIP insurance. This amount will cover all PIP benefits including medical bills. If the policy only covers \$10,000, the victim may not be able to collect payment for lost wages if their bills exceed that amount.

In the article, attorney Charlip adds, "Aside from recovering compensation for past lost wages, you may also be able to recover compensation for future lost wages. Depending on your injuries, future loss of income would include future lost wages and the reduction in earning potential due to a disability or permanent impairment."
