First of all, glutamine may be able to help with stress management and brain health. It may offer protection against cell damage, DNA damage, hydrogen peroxide-induced stress, and beta-amyloid. Supplementation may also help seniors suffering from neurodegenerative disease in adjusting to pressure. Second, it may enhance gut health and this is vital because a *?Food Science and Human Wellness?* article has explained that poor gut health may contribute to poor overall health. According to the said article, glutamine may help by stabilizing the gut microbiome and reducing inflammation when the gut is irritated.

A third benefit of glutamine is that it may help with ulcers. This amino acid has been observed to help fight Helicobacter pylori in the stomach. In addition, a study found that this amino acid may stimulate ammonia detox in the stomach and in the liver, thus decreasing the effective concentration of ammonia with the result that cell damage is prevented. Fourth, glutamine may help in reducing muscle pain and in promoting athletic recovery after a physical event. However, it was noted that the recovery effect was more significant in men compared to women. And fifth, glutamine may enhance immune function because the immune cells need this amino acid to be able to do their function. When there is insufficient glutamine in the body, the body will try to get it from protein in the body, which are mostly found in the muscles.

Meanwhile, histidine is another amino acid that they may include in their IV therapy drips. They are also the building blocks for protein used for creating enzymes. And most of all, histidine supplementation is a necessity because the human body does not produce this amino acid. Studies have shown that histidine may help reduce oxidative stress and enhance cellular function in the body when used in combination with other IV amino acids. Furthermore, histidine may be a natural antioxidant and may have anti-inflammatory effects.
