If this issue is just left untreated, it can worsen into a more serious issue and require a more expensive repair. Another technique they can use is the use of micropiles, which are deep foundation elements that can be used for any type of base or soil. Even with their small diameters, they are capable of holding hundreds of tons of weight. The third technique is soil nailing, which can be used to address unstable soil on slopes that can result into foundation damage. This is important because reinforcing the soil is a way to repair a foundation. And finally, rock anchors can be provided to stabilize the structure into the foundation.

Piedmont Foundation Repair (PFR) can also provide crawl space repair. A crawl space may sometimes be found in a home in place of a basement. It is a smaller space and typically just large enough for a person to crawl through. Its purpose is to provide access to plumbing and electrical wires. Problems with a crawl space may be present such as floors above the crawl space that are sinking or dipping below other spaces. Moisture and humidity can also affect the indoor air quality.
