A spokesperson for ClearSight remarks, ?Advanced Surface Ablation (ASA), also known as Photorefractive Keratectomy (PRK), is a type of refractive laser surgery that is effective in patients with thinner corneas, minor corneal irregularities, or for patients with specific occupations/hobbies such as contact sports. It has been shown to provide results that are as good as LASIK. If you wear glasses or contact lenses laser vision correction could provide the visual freedom you have been looking for. At the start of the procedure, the vision correction surgeon puts anesthetic eye drops in the eye to ensure that the patient will feel no pain or discomfort. Next, the surgeon will gently remove the epithelial tissue covering the cornea. This is followed by a procedure that is similar to the one done for LASIK. Using an excimer laser, the surgeon reshapes the outer surface of the eye to correct the patient?s nearsightedness, farsightedness, and/or astigmatism. After the work with the laser is done, the surgeon places a special contact lens for the

protection of the cornea while the epithelium is healing.

Good candidates for the Advanced PRK procedures are patients in their 20s or 30s who want a safe and effective alternative to eyeglasses or contact lenses, and would benefit from this LASIK alternative. PRK surgery is considered to be gentle and as safe as LASIK surgery.

Advanced PRK surgery offers various benefits. First of all, it is considered to be safe for patients who are engaged in contact sports or are in active military service. Second, there is minimal removal of the body?s natural tissue. Third, it is suitable for those with thin corneas. And lastly, it allows the patient to no longer be dependent on eyeglasses or contact lenses.

The surgeons at ClearSight want to point out that laser vision correction has improved through the years, and it is now capable of addressing a broader array of vision problems and treat patients who were previously considered to be untreatable. With their three unique lasers, they are able to tailor-fit the treatment for each specific patient. When used with the most advanced diagnostic equipment and software, they are often able to use the lasers to provide patients with vision that is clearer than 20/20.
