This cycle is repeated several times during the night, resulting into an interrupted sleep. Sleep apnea has been found to be linked to high blood pressure, heart disease, type 2 diabetes, and other conditions. And most people who used a CPAP machine immediately noticed the difference in their health.

The CPAP machine works by delivering air pressure to the mask worn by the person and this increases the pressure in the throat so that the airway will not collapse while the person is asleep. There are various kinds of masks for CPAP machines, such as those that simply cover the nose, those that cover the mouth, and those that cover both the nose and mouth. It is important to note that all of these masks all work well and

CPAP users are simply advised to choose the one that is most comfortable for them.

CPAP therapy has indeed become mainstream because in 2022, there are already more than 8 million CPAP users in the US and this number is increasing by 8 to 9 percent every year. Nevertheless, doctors still estimate that most people who have sleep apnea have been undiagnosed. Many people who are suffering from sleep apnea feel tired all the time but they don't realize it is due to sleep apnea.
