Lastly, the cosmetic dentist will look for discolouration, stains, and unsightly fillings and offer the possible solutions. After providing the various

solutions, the patient is provided with a much improved smile.

At Acacia Dental Group, they offer the latest advances in cosmetic dentistry technology, such as: inlays and onlays; CEREC dental crowns; white dental fillings; dental veneers; crowns and bridges; and teeth whitening. CEREC technology has made it much easier for patients to benefit from restorations for damaged or missing teeth. Previously, patients would need to wait for weeks to have the final restorations, such as dental crowns, permanently bonded to their teeth. Thus, patients would need to be fitted with temporary restorations while waiting for the permanent ones. The long wait has been eliminated with CEREC technology. In addition, the restorations are not just faster but they are also more accurate and longer-lasting because of the use of computer-aided design to produce the crowns, veneers, fixed bridges, dental implants, and more.

Another notable improvement in cosmetic dentistry is the digital smile design, which makes use of digital imaging and digital software technology. This technology allows for a thorough and accurate analysis of the patient's dental and facial characteristics and dimensions. It allows the cosmetic dentist to have a better sense of the relationship between the teeth, gums, lips and other facial features that contribute to the patient's smile. Intraoral scanners are used to provide a 3D image of the patient's smile. The cosmetic dentist may browse through a digital library of the different forms and shapes that may be placed over the tops of the teeth in the images, allowing the patient to visualise the resulting smile for various kinds of treatment. Upon the patient's approval for a particular solution, the dentist can start the restoration process.
