Deployment, for instance, has some connection to unhealthy drinking habits, smoke inhalation and drug use, and the organization says that this may be why some veterans develop drug addiction or alcohol addiction after they have been out of active service for some time. Exacerbating the issue is the fact that current protocols take a zero tolerance approach to addiction, making people in this situation less likely to seek help over concerns regarding the
