According to the lawyer, no one enters a marriage expecting it to end. If there are children involved, it is important to have the best experience possible during divorce proceedings.

"Each marital partner comes at divorce and amount of child support from a unique perspective. In many cases, that is one of the reasons for divorce in the first place. But when it comes to co-parenting children during and after a divorce, each partner is tasked with the need to come together to put the children's needs ahead of their own. This applies equally to both the custodial and the noncustodial parent," says the New York City child support lawyer.

According to the lawyer, many clients want to know how child maintenance is calculated. The income and

custody of the parents will determine how much child support is required. The New York State Family Laws require parents to support their children up until the age of 21 or until they are financially emancipated.

Attorney Luciano states that child support must be paid by the noncustodial parent to the custodial parent for the child's benefit. The child support system in New York is based on the number and amount of children.

Attorney Luciano explains that child support for one child should be equal to 17% of both parents' combined gross income. 25% for 2 children; 29% for 3 children; 31% for 4 children; 31% for 5 kids. Every 2 years, a review of the cost of living is recommended.

The noncustodial parent is also required to pay child support once the family court has made its decision. The noncustodial parent who fails to pay child support may have them enforced by the other parent, with the help of a child support lawyer.

Attorney Juan Luciano also explains that many factors can change the lives of both parents and that it can be necessary to modify the child support order. A judge will examine the factors and determine whether those changes warrant a modification and by how much.

Lastly, the divorce attorney emphasizes that it is very important to seek the help of an experienced lawyer to ensure that they understand their rights and responsibilities in the case.
