There are various kinds of crickets in the ecosystem. These include: King crickets, Jerusalem cricket, Camel cricket, and Mormon crickets. House crickets are nocturnal, which means they are hidden during the day. They are typically found in warm areas of the home, such as the kitchen, fireplace, basement, and in cracks and crevices behind the baseboard. They often cause damage to paper, woolen clothes, silk, all types of food, and rubber, although the damage is just minor, unless they are present in huge numbers.

House crickets usually have a lifespan of 90 days, depending on the season and the presence of predators.

Some crickets have been found to survive in homes for more than two years or even more without cold weather and predation. But in general, crickets will rarely live for longer than a few weeks. The interior of homes typically provide the optimum environment for crickets, which is why people who want to get rid of them need to act fast. It is also important to note that crickets may not just be annoying because of the noise they make but they can bite or chew on various items in the home. And the damage can be significant if a large number of crickets are able to enter the home. As the weather gets colder, more crickets will try to seek shelter in homes. Thus, it may be a good idea to get the help of professional pest control technicians, such as those who work at Backyard Bug Patrol.
