According to traffic law, right-of-way means the right to proceed. When two vehicles or parties come to or occupy the same area or intersection simultaneously, one of these parties will lawfully have the right-of-way. All states have laws that detail circumstances when a driver, cyclist, or pedestrian has the right-of-way or must grant the right-of-way to another party, the NYC car accident attorney says.

According to the lawyer, failure to yield accidents was the fourth most common cause of fatalities in the United States in 2018, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. The rising number of cyclist and pedestrian deaths in New York City is also due to the failure to yield the right-of-way.

Attorney Samantha Kucher says there are specific right-of-way laws in New York. State legislators have enacted stricter laws and penalties to ensure everyone knows their rights and responsibilities when they're on the road. New York City is still a hotbed for right-of-way violations.

In the article, the lawyer says that failure to yield often occurs at intersections. This includes failure to obey signs and signals, failure to yield when there are no signs or signals, left-hand turns at intersections, T-intersection right-of-way, and four-way stops.

Pedestrians are also responsible for their own actions on our streets in New York City. While drivers of

vehicles have the bulk of the responsibility for yielding the right-of-way, pedestrians who do not follow their own rules can be held accountable if an accident results,? says the accident attorney.
