The order requires a signature from a judge, and once served, it is enforceable anywhere within the United States. There are two types of restraining orders: domestic and stalking.?

The lawyer explains that domestic restraining orders are usually served by a current or former spouse, someone who the defendant is dating, and someone with a home with whom the defendant has a child in common. A stalking restraining order is an order that protects a person whose behavior and actions consist of two or more acts without the other?s consent. These actions can include threats, harassment, and others.

Attorney Paul J. Tafelski says that there can be certain situations where a restraining order is not an option. For example, a minor child cannot get an order against a parent and vice versa. In the aforementioned examples, the parties are recommended to contact the Juvenile Division of Family Court.

In the article, the lawyer adds, ?Paying attention to the details of the order and to scheduled court dates is crucial for not violating the terms and for not missing court. While receiving a PPO may upset you, it is important to remain calm when served with one. It is equally important to contact a Michigan criminal defense lawyer as soon as possible.?
