A small Botox injection at both sides of the nostril and nose to mouth lines will help weaken the muscles response and reduce the gummy smile effect. The procedure is minimally invasive and will actually begin to show results within just 5 to 7 days. As with most botox treatments, the treatment requires no downtime to recuperate, and patients can resume their daily activities straight away.
