Property owners may be able to revoke the deed or sell the property whenever they want while they are still alive because this type of deed only takes effect once the creator is deceased.

In the article, attorney Thompson says, "Living trusts are a great way to avoid probate in Texas. Nearly any sort of property can be protected by a trust, so it's a great way for property owners to transfer houses, cars, bank accounts, and other valuable assets to their beneficiaries without getting the court involved. All you have to do is create the trust, name a successor trustee, and give yourself ownership of the property within

the trust.?
