This law applies to all types of scaffolding, including ladders, cherry pickers, and other devices used for elevation, the Queens construction accident attorney says.

In addition to the requirements outlined in the Scaffold Law, there are also OSHA regulations that must be

followed when using scaffolding. These regulations include requirements for the strength and stability of scaffolding, as well as requirements for the placement of scaffolding in relation to power lines and other potential hazards.

If a worker is injured while working on scaffolding in New York, they may be entitled to compensation for their injuries. Under the Scaffold Law, owners and contractors are strictly liable for any injuries that occur due to their failure to provide proper scaffolding or other safety devices. This means that even if the owner or contractor was not negligent, they may still be held liable for the worker's injuries.

In the article, the lawyer adds, "A worker's compensation settlement is not always sufficient to cover costs that have been incurred in an injury or future medical attention that may be needed.
