First, ask yourself what season of the year it is. If it is fall, then you should avoid pruning the

trees at all costs. If it is during winter, then that's the right time to prune the trees. This is because, during winter, the trees are dormant, hence pruning will be less stressful for the tree.

The CEO also noted that making the pruning cuts wrongly and using the wrong tools and equipment were also some of the mistakes done during pruning.

"When pruning the trees," said the CEO, "people tend to make the pruning cuts wrongly. This includes making flush cuts, stub cuts, lion tailing, and heading cuts. Making wrong cuts damages the tree structurally and aesthetically. Also, using the wrong tools when performing the procedure harms the trees. When pruning, make sure that the size and power of the tool match that of the branches. It should also be sharp and properly tuned."
