After that, the dead, dying, and diseased branches need to be pruned before they begin to leaf out. Also, when checking for dead and diseased

branches, look at the general tree structure, if you find a tree that has been injured a lot, remove it.?

?While still working on winter effects,? said the CEO, ?check for the pests that infested the tree during winter. When looking for a place to hide from the winter cold season, the pests settle in the trees. When the weather starts becoming warm, the pests start becoming visible, and hence the right time to deal with them. The pests should be removed, and preventive measures put in place to prevent them from returning.?

?Spring is known to have a lot of storms,? said the CEO. ?To be well prepared for the storms installing lightning protection is recommended since the trees are a top target for lightning.?

?Most tree conditions are attributed to the soil,? said the CEO. ?Therefore, after installing lightning protection, check the soil structure, and improve it to ensure healthy growth of trees. How do you do this? Add fresh mulch to the trees. Mulching not only helps to improve the soil structure by adding organic matter, retaining moisture, and maintaining soil temperatures, but also helps to suppress weeds. Fertilization will also help to improve the soil by adding nutrients essential for the growth of the trees. A slow-release fertilizer is recommended for long-term benefits to the trees.?
