Marriage annulment will make a marriage disappear as though it never happened in the first place.

Fraud is one of the few grounds for annulment. Fraud is the making of intentional misrepresentation, with the knowledge that the other party will rely on it, and attaining the other party's consent as a result. Basically, lying about something important in order to get the other person to marry you, says the Florida divorce lawyer.

The process for obtaining an annulment in Florida is similar to the process for obtaining a divorce. The spouse seeking the annulment must file a petition with the court, stating the grounds for the annulment. The other spouse will then have the opportunity to respond to the petition. If both parties agree to the annulment, the process can be relatively quick and straightforward. However, if there is disagreement, the case may go to trial, where a judge will decide whether or not the marriage should be annulled.

One important difference between divorce and annulment is the effect on property division and alimony. In a divorce, the court will divide the couple's assets and debts and may award alimony to one spouse. In an annulment, however, the court will not divide property or award alimony, as the marriage is considered to have never existed. This means that any assets or debts accumulated during the marriage will remain with the individual spouse.

It is also worth noting that an annulment does not affect the legitimacy of any children born during the marriage. The court will still have jurisdiction over child custody and support matters in an annulment case.
