This is also the same for units that have some age on them where the repair estimate is very high. Replacement is also a good idea if someone wants to upgrade to a much newer and more energy-efficient HVAC model. Bobadilla also mentioned that choosing whether to repair or replace an HVAC unit should be a decision that is never solely based on initial cost. That's because, in the long run, a new HVAC system may prove to be the less-expensive option. The reason for this is new furnace models have become very energy efficient. Some will save more than enough money on energy bills to pay for themselves over the long run. It was also brought up by him that they do also offer some convenient financing options so purchasing a new HVAC unit will not take such a big bite out of a customer's budget. 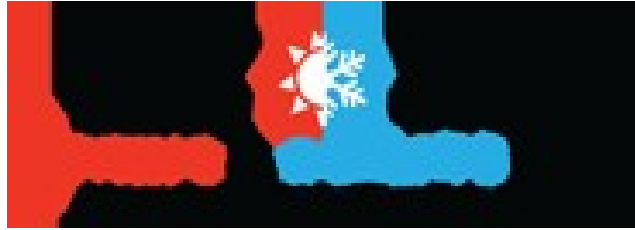
