



## NY Child Support Lawyer Juan Luciano Explains How to Calculate Child Support in New York

The lawyer mentions that parents are required to financially support their children under New York law. When parents separate or get divorced, the court legally requires this responsibility through a child support order.

Child support, also referred to as child maintenance, in New York is typically dependent on who holds custody of the child. In most cases, the court requires the noncustodial parent to pay child support to the custodial parent. This financial support is to be used for the child's needs, the NY child support lawyer says.

The lawyer explains that many clients usually want to know how child support is calculated. This will depend on the couple's custody situation and the income of both parties. Under the New York State family laws, parents are required to support their children until they reach the age of 21 or until they are financially

emancipated.

Attorney Luciano says that the noncustodial parent is required to pay child support to the custodial parent for the benefit of the child. In New York's child support model, the proportions are fixed and applied to the gross income of both parents depending on the number of children.

In the article, attorney Luciano discusses that for 1 child, the child support should be 17% of the combined gross income of both parents. 25% for 2 children, 29% for 3 children, 31% for four children, and 31% for 5 children. A cost of living review should also take place every 2 years.

Furthermore, once the family court made its decision, the noncustodial parent must pay child support. If the noncustodial parent fails to pay child support, they may be enforced by the other parent with the assistance of a child support lawyer.

Attorney Juan Luciano also explains that many things may change the lives of each parent and this could mean that the child support order must be modified. A judge will examine the fact and determine whether those changes warrant a modification and by how much.

Lastly, the divorce attorney emphasizes that it is very important to seek the help of an experienced lawyer to ensure that they understand their rights and responsibilities in the case.
