"Sexually transmitted infections are some of the most hidden epidemics in the US," says Meetpositives.com. "According to the CDC, there are 20 million new viral infections every year. The most common STI/STDs in the US are Gonorrhea, Chlamydia, Hepatitis B, Genital Herpes, HIV, Syphilis, Trichomoniasis and Human Papillomavirus (HPV). The infections that occur each year cost about \$16 billion in treatment. Approximately 50% of these infections involve people between the ages of 15-24. The main reason behind this percentage is because sexual activity is occurring the most in this age bracket. The above viruses infect almost 59.5 million people and about 50.5 million men are infected. This accounts for approximately 110 million people living with STDs in the US."
