

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Substance abuse (also known as drug abuse) is a patterned use of a drug in which the user consumes the substance in amounts or with methods which are harmful to themselves or others, and in a form or substance which is socially widely differing definitions of drug abuse are used in public health, medical and criminal justice contexts. In some cases, criminal or anti-social behavior occurs when the person is under the influence of a drug, and long term personality changes (in individuals) may occur as well. In addition to possible physical, social and psychological harm, use of some drugs may also lead to criminal penalties, although these vary widely depending on the local jurisdiction.



COST



EUROPE

The UK has reported by 10 countries categorized according to the functions of government, amounting to a total of EUR 2.17 billion. Overall, the highest proportion of this total came within the government functions of Health (60%) (e.g. medical services) and Public Order and Safety (20%) (e.g. police services, law courts, prisons).



UNITED KINGDOM

The UK Home Office estimated that the social and economic cost of drug abuse in the UK economy in terms of crime, absenteeism and sickness, is a total of £2 billion a year. However, the UK Home Office does not estimate what portion of those crimes are unintended consequences of drug prohibition (e.g. to sustain expensive drug consumption, risky production and dangerous distribution) or what is the cost of enforcement.



UNITED STATES

These figures represent overall consumer costs, which can be divided in three major categories: health care, criminal justice expenditures.

Health-related costs were projected to total \$16 billion in 2002. Productivity losses were estimated at \$128.6 billion. In contrast to other costs of drug abuse (which involve direct expenditures for goods and services), this value reflects a loss of potential earnings of the individual workers. The total for criminal justice has been performed about the impact of drug abuse. It includes expenditures for law enforcement, courts, and corrections.

The non-health care expenditures primarily concern costs associated with the criminal justice system and crime victim care, but also include a modest level of expenses for administrative costs of the judicial system. The total for criminal justice costs is for state and federal combined at \$14.2 billion, which is mostly for the operation of prisons. Another \$2.6 billion was allocated for federal supply reduction initiatives.

IMMIGRANTS AND REFUGEES

Immigrant and refugees have often been under great stress, physical trauma and depression and anxiety due to separation from loved ones and disruption of their culture and language. This is followed by "culture shock", language barriers, racism, discrimination, economic adversity, overcrowding, social isolation and difficulty obtaining work and forms of education and recreation.



STREET CHILDREN

Street children in many developing countries are a high risk group for substance misuse, in particular alcohol abuse. They are often exposed to drug use through street vendors who work against the hardship of life on the street. Street children are often family poor group and a potent symbol of urban deprivation.



MUSICIANS

In order to maintain high-quality performance, some musicians take periodic substance abuse. As a group they have a higher rate of alcohol abuse, and a higher rate of cocaine abuse. This is due to the nature of their work, which is often performed in high-pressure situations.



VETERANS

Substance abuse can be another contributing factor that affects physical and mental health of veterans. Substance abuse may also increase the risk of suicidal thoughts and actions. It is important to recognize that substance abuse disproportionately affects the homeless veteran population.
