The best way to distinguish between each type of leather is to rub a small drop of water onto the surface and see what happens next?.

The article states that ?the most commonly found and also the easiest to clean and maintain are Pigmented coloured shoes. They recommend applying Colourlock Elephant Leather Preserver to this type of shoes and boots to make them water repellent, particularly important for hiking or hunting gear?.

This material is also not appropriate for wet weather conditions as stains are easily visible immediately'.
