Thus, there are many cases where both the drug or alcohol abuse may co-exist with a mental health disorder in a patient.

Meanwhile, there are short-term and long-term detox programs. Short-term detox and rehab programs, which usually last from three to 30 days. It is common for people struggling with an addiction to go for a 30 day detox and rehab process but sometimes a 21 day drug rehabs program may be sufficient, depending on the drug abused, the severity of the addiction, and other factors.

The problem with addiction is that it prevents people from quitting the use of the addictive substance because they suffer from cravings and other temptations. If they try to quit or even reduce the amount they have been

taking, they also suffer from withdrawal symptoms, and eventually get back to taking the drug and may even likely increase their dosage. Withdrawal symptoms can be very uncomfortable and can vary from mild to life-threatening, depending on a number of factors.

An important step in the drug rehab program is detox, which helps the person struggling with an addiction to cope with the withdrawal symptoms, such as appetite changes, mood changes, bone pain, hallucinations, nausea, vomiting, muscle pain, runny nose, restlessness, diarrhea, tremors, sleeping difficulties, seizures, and fever. In some cases, medical detox may be recommended where medication is provided to minimize the withdrawal symptoms while the patient is monitored by a doctor.

It is important to note that rehab facilities vary in the kinds of amenities that they provide. What is common is that they provide a room to sleep in, regular meals, continuous medical support, and regular therapy sessions. Patients need to follow a certain schedule, such as rising early in the morning in order to develop discipline. Some rehab programs offer yoga, meditation, and morning classes to help patients maintain a relaxed state of mind. Treatment has a lot to do with helping the patients develop healthier habits

During rehab, patients also get to meet several people who can support them in their path towards recovery. The morning sessions are usually followed by sessions led by a counselor or therapist. These usually include individual behavioral therapy, group therapy, family therapy, and other specialized sessions. The individual sessions are designed to help the patient open up and share what they are feeling, their fears, and their concerns. Group therapy would be focused on the social aspect of the recovery process as it allows the patients to interact with other people and share their experiences with the group. In the family therapy, problems like anger and resentment can be addressed. Sometimes, it is this anger and resentment that has pushed people into using drugs or alcohol.
