It can also be smoked or inhaled.

Due to the high level of impurities in the final product, black tar heroin is much more dangerous than other opioids and puts users at a higher risk of illness and death. It has a purity level of about 30%. Black tar heroin is especially hazardous for the lungs and can lead to a wide range of side effects.

Some of the common side effects of taking black tar heroin include collapsed veins (from injecting), abscesses, constipation or bowel obstructions, kidney disease, liver disease, lung disease, the onset or worsening of mental health conditions, hallucinations, insomnia, infections in the lining of the heart,

abdominal cramping, irregular periods, erectile dysfunction, and more.
