This is a complex situation where three potential entities could be held responsible, which are: the driver of the truck, the company for whom the driver works, and third-party individuals or companies. They want to advise those who got involved in a truck accident to get help from an accident lawyer who specializes in truck accidents.

Ronnie Mabra from The Mabra Law Firm says, "The truck driver is usually the most obvious defendant because they are directly involved in the crash. For example, a delivery driver might drive too fast on a highway and hit another vehicle head-on. In that case, the delivery driver could be liable for negligence. If another company employs the truck driver, that company may also be liable. Employers, in this case the delivery companies, are often held vicariously liable for the actions of their employees. Vicarious liability refers to the doctrine where employers are held legally responsible for the negligent acts of their employees. Some accidents involve multiple defendants. For instance, a motor vehicle accident could occur due to a faulty auto part. When that happens, the third-party company that produced the auto part and the delivery company for not doing proper inspections could both be liable."

Those who have been injured as a result of the negligence of another individual operating a commercial delivery truck, such as a tractor-trailer, can possibly claim the driver to be liable and request for compensation. However, it is essential to know the kinds of claims covered by the commercial auto insurance policy. This policy may cover many of the risks related to driving a commercial motor vehicle, such as: bodily injury, uninsured and underinsured motorists, medical bills, cargo liability, and more. Bodily injury coverage includes those damages caused by physical contact with another individual, including death. Medical bills coverage is for the expenses for emergency medical care. Property damage covers damages to vehicles and equipment resulting from a collision with another object. Uninsured or underinsured motorists coverage is for damages due to the negligent operation of a vehicle without sufficient insurance protection.

Meanwhile, with regards to the liability of the employer of the truck driver in a delivery truck accident, the courts and the insurance firm will consider a number of factors when determining whether a worker is an employee or an independent contractor. These include whether: the worker is receiving wages; the work is done as part of the regular business of the company; the worker does work beyond the normal working hours; and the worker is free to render similar types of work for others.
