Gum disease, or periodontal disease, affects, to some extent, nearly half of all adults in the United States 30 years or older. Caused by a buildup of bacteria in the mouth and the eventual formation of plaque, or worse, tartar, the symptoms of gum disease can range from mild to severe including red, swollen, or bleeding gums, gum infections, bad breath, loose teeth, gum recession, pus between the teeth and gums, changes in bite or tooth alignment, and more.

The development of gum disease can be broadly split into three phases. Stage 1 gum disease, or gingivitis, can be reversed by following good oral hygiene habits such as brushing and flossing. Periodontitis, or Stage 2 gum disease, is characterized by damage to the bone and fibers that support the teeth. Finally, advanced periodontitis can lead to the formation of deep pockets between the teeth and gums, receding gums, loose

teeth, and changes in bite or tooth alignment.

Advanced Periodontics & Dental Implants recommends several treatments for mitigating and reversing the effects of gum disease. Scaling and root planing, also known as deep cleaning, is usually the first step in treating gum disease. It involves removing plaque and tartar from the teeth and gums to smooth out rough spots on the tooth roots and prevent bacteria from accumulating.

In conjunction with scaling and root planing, dentists may prescribe oral or topically applied antibiotics to control bacterial infections, reduce inflammation, and promote healing. Another option is the use of minimally invasive laser therapy to remove bacteria and diseased tissue from the gums. Finally, to address advanced periodontitis, surgery may be required to remove diseased tissue and restore the gums to a healthy state. Some of the common surgical techniques used include gum grafts, bone grafts, and pocket reduction surgery.
