Spray foam insulation is sprayed in liquid form into the area that needs insulation, including rim joists, attics, crawl spaces, and new construction. This type of insulation provides a number of advantages. Second, it will also block some of the noise from the outside, making the home more peaceful and quieter. Furthermore, because the spray foam insulation seals the tiny gaps and holes in the walls, it can prevent the entry of ants, bugs, other insects, and small rodents. Spray foam insulation, especially the closed cell type, has high density and hardness, which means it can add to the structural strength of the home, helping it withstand strong winds, heavy snow, and earthquakes. Lastly, spray foam insulation is environmentally friendly.

This involves blowing bits of insulation material into spaces in the home or building that require insulation. The insulation material is usually made of fiberglass fibers or cellulose material. Installation requires the use of a mechanical blower and hopper. The insulation material is churned with paddles to loosen it and combine it with air and then this is blown through hoses and directed to the cavities to be filled with insulation.

Blown-in insulation is typically used for the attic, which usually requires unrolling fiberglass insulation. A faster way to provide insulation for the attic is through blown-in insulation. In just one or two hours, a thick blanket of loose insulation can be installed across the attic floor. This is an eco-friendly option because the insulation material is usually made from recycled materials.
