deep or large wound; carbon monoxide exposure; sudden blindness or severe eye injury; abdominal pain;

pregnancy related concerns; sexual assault; vaginal bleeding (non-pregnancy); and partial or full paralysis.

Davenport and surrounding areas. This is a clinic where patients don?t need to have an appointment. They
