mental status (such as unusual behavior, confusion, or difficulty arousing); chest pain; choking, coughing or vomiting blood; fainting or loss of consciousness; feelings of wanting to harm oneself or others; head or spine injury; severe or persistent vomiting or diarrhea; sudden injury due to motor vehicle injury; burns or smoke inhalation; near drowning; a deep or large wound; sudden dizziness, weakness or change in vision; swallowing a poisonous substance; abdominal pain; carbon monoxide exposure; sudden blindness or severe eye injury; sexual assault; pregnancy related concerns; partial or full paralysis; and vaginal bleeding (non-pregnancy).

A spokesperson for Amana Care Clinic explains, ?What?s the difference between the ER and Amana Care Clinic? The emergency room and Amana Care Clinic are healthcare facilities that treat medical emergencies. In general, Amana Care Clinic is for minor, non-life-threatening situations, like a bad earache or a sprained ankle.
