The exact percentage needed to pass the trade examination varies and is communicated at the test site.

?The test is conducted on a computer-assisted testing (CAT) system,? says Eric. ?This is the same system that our own computer testing center is modeled after. So, our students get the chance to simulate the law and trade examinations they will take on a computer at the State Board. Our practice tests help our students become intimately familiar and comfortable with taking the exam with the computer.?

Contractors State License Center also offers a home study program where students can purchase books, study guides, and practice exams to prepare for their test by studying the material at home.
