The importance of dual diagnosis treatment is recognized by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), a branch of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. More than 20 million adults in the U.S. have a substance use disorder, and some 38 percent of them also struggle with mental illness, according to SAMHSA. At the same time, 42 million U.S. adults have a mental health disorder and 18.2 percent are also diagnosed with substance use disorders.

Many addicts find their dual diagnosis has its roots in traumatic events like abuse, major accidents, or grief from the shattering loss of a loved one. They may have turned to drugs or alcohol as a way of self-medicating the psychic pain caused by the trauma, such as anxiety, depression, or post-traumatic stress disorder. For others, the addiction comes first and leads to the psychological condition. However, it developed, that the dual diagnosis must be treated as one disorder. If only the addiction is treated and the mental illness is not resolved, the chance of relapse is high.

This sophisticated approach to substance abuse and mental illness is part of an even larger context that treats the whole person, not just their illness ? a critical element for Kirk.
