To understand what nitro cold brew is, it is important to have some knowledge of the typical cold brew. Briefly put, cold brew coffee requires three primary ingredients: coffee grounds, cold water and time.

In most cases, cold brew coffee is made by steeping coffee in water for anywhere between 8 - 24 hours at either low (or even ambient) temperatures. This has a dramatic effect on the taste, with most reporting that it tends to take out much of the beverage's acidity. It can also result in a greater ratio of caffeine. Those attempting this at home may find it can be far more convenient as well due to the brewing process being less complex (it essentially extracts coffee from beans with time instead of heat, which necessitates additional apparatus).

Nitro cold brew, as the name implies, is made in a similar manner, with one additional ingredient. This ingredient is nitrogen gas. As Starbucks shares on its official page for Nitro Cold Brew, "Our Nitro Cold Brew is created when our signature Cold Brew (slow-steeped for 20 hours) is infused with nitrogen as it pours from the tap. Nitrogen infusion creates microbubbles, giving the coffee a cascading, frothy texture. The result is a velvety-smooth coffee with a subtly sweet flavor and a rich, creamy head of foam."

The reduced acidity makes it easier for some to enjoy the beverage's sweeter, fruity notes, and its frothy texture allows it to settle on the tongue in an exceedingly pleasant manner. Some may find it intriguing to examine who this kind of coffee appeals to. For one, the eccentricity and style associated with nitro cold brew may make it appeal more to a younger crowd, such as students who are dealing with massive workloads (the increased caffeine content may help here). This is especially true given that this demographic is often more willing to try new trends. However, there are other factors that should be taken into account as well.

For instance, the nitrogen gas infusion adds a hint of sweetness to the flavor, which means it requires less sugar. It also does not use milk, making it great for anyone who is trying to reduce their dairy intake and still be able to enjoy a sweeter coffee. The overall smoother taste can even make nitro cold brew have less of an impact on those with sensitive stomachs. As such, there is a chance that nitro cold brew will see a steady rise in popularity with older generations, and those who enjoy the drink young may find less reason to give it up as they age.

Notably, while the advantages of the beverage's extra caffeine are obvious, drinkers should also be aware of the potential negative effects. When consumed in excessive amounts, it can cause a range of unwanted symptoms, such as headaches, insomnia and more.
