The All on 4 is a full arch dental implant procedure that takes an innovative approach, in contrast to other teeth replacement alternatives. Full mouth dental implants or All-on-4 implants is an innovative method for dental implants. While the basic concept is similar to that of traditional dental implants, the innovation is to use a unique angle for the implants as a way to avoid those parts of the jawbone that are low in density and to maximise the strength of the support for the full arch of implants. This innovation makes the procedure appropriate for more people and eliminates the need for preliminary procedures. The full mouth implant technique is also faster, less costly, and heals more quickly because it only requires four dental implants to support a whole arch of teeth, instead

of eight implants using conventional implant methods.

At Dental Implants Tasmania, the procedure for full mouth dental implants has three key stages. The first stage is the initial consultation and thorough evaluation. During this stage, the dentist will examine the oral and general health of the patient and take into account any health conditions that may affect the treatment. They will take 3D x-rays to get a full picture of the patient's mouth and jawbone. The second stage is the placement of the implants. Their anaesthetist will make sure the procedure will be pain-free and as comfortable as possible and a highly trained implant dentist will place the implants, after which, he will attach the replacement teeth to the implants. Finally, the dentist will check the patient's bite and ensure the patient is satisfied.

The third stage is the after care. Right after the procedure, they will provide the patient with advice on what to eat and to drink plenty of water. The patient will also be advised to avoid smoking. It's important to remember that it will take six months for the jawbone to completely fuse with the implants and to take care of them while they are not yet at full strength.

Dental Implants Tasmania was founded by Dr. Bing Lee and his wife, Dr. Fay Chan, and is a dental practice that is part of Innova Dental. The vision is to offer advanced restorative dental procedures in Launceston and the broader Tasmanian community. Dental Implants Tasmania is a purpose-built clinic that uses advanced technologies to enhance the outcome of the treatment they provide.

Dr. Bing Lee grew up and graduated in Singapore, and then earned his dental degree from the University of Queensland in 2013.
